Chapter 5
Student Services**

AP 5200 Student Health Services

The following provisions shall apply to each student enrolling in credit classes and to students enrolling exclusively in noncredit classes who choose to pay the student health fee during the fall or spring semesters, or summer term or winter intersession, at either Golden West College or Orange Coast College, upon payment of the applicable student health fee.

1. Students shall receive limited basic health care services, and the student's health care insurance shall be handled at the primary College where they are enrolled. The "primary College" is the College where the health fee was paid. The scope of such limited health care services may be periodically amended.
2. Students who have paid the student health fee for Golden West College or Orange Coast College may be authorized to receive first aid and emergency health care at either of these two Colleges' student health centers, on an emergency basis or as approved by each College's health center.

Students enrolling in classes only at Coastline Community College are eligible for health services at Orange Coast College or Golden West College as long as Coastline Community College maintains an agreement with either College as provider.

Individuals Deemed Ineligible for Health Service

Students who drop all classes prior to the end of the semester/term become ineligible for health service at the time at which all classes are dropped.

In situations where a person is in a medical crisis, the staff at the Student Health Center may, at their discretion, provide emergency health care, mental health care, and first aid to students and non-students who are ineligible for regular health services. In these situations, the Student Health Center staff will assess and stabilize the situation, then provide case management to connect the person to other appropriate services outside of the College.
