Student Services

AP 5200 Student Health Services

The following provisions shall apply to each student enrolling in credit classes during the fall or spring semesters, or summer term or winter intersession, at both Golden West College and Orange Coast College, when classes are in session, upon payment of the applicable student health fee

1. Students shall receive limited basic health care services at the primary college where he/she has enrolled, and the student's health care insurance shall be handled at the college where the student is enrolled. The primary college is the college where the health fee was paid. The scope of such limited health care services may be periodically amended.
2. Students who have paid the student health fee for Golden West College or Orange Coast College may be authorized to receive first aid and emergency health care at either of these two colleges' student health centers, on an emergency basis or as approved by each college health center.

Students attending Coastline Community College shall be entitled to receive limited health services with a third-party provider contracted for by the college, during semesters, terms or intersessions for which they hold an enrolled status in credit course(s), upon payment of a student health fee. The scope of such services may be periodically amended.

Individuals Deemed Ineligible for Health Service

Students who drop all credit classes prior to the end of the semester/term become ineligible for health service at the time at which all credit classes are dropped.

Students enrolling in classes only at Coastline Community College are ineligible for health services at Orange Coast College or Golden West College. Coastline Community College students may receive limited health services with a third-party provider contracted for by the college, during semesters, terms or intersessions when they have an enrolled status in credit course(s) enrolled status, and have paid a student health fee.
