12. Approval of Educational Administrator Agreement for Madjid Niroumand Orange Coast College

After review by the Vice Chancellor of Human Resources, it is recommended by the Chancellor that the Board approve the employment agreement with Madjid Niroumand, Interim Associate Dean of Student Services, Orange Coast College effective October 7, 2010 through June 30, 2011. Compensation to be \$9,339.66 per month based on appropriate step placement. The Board President, or designee, is authorized to sign the Agreement and any related documents, indicating approval by the Board of Trustees. (See Attachment # 1)

13. Approve Emeritus Designation to Mr. C.M. Brahmbhatt as Vice Chancellor Emeritus of Administrative Services, Coast Community College District

Background: The Board Policy 050-1-5.1 provides opportunity for the Board of Trustees to grant emeritus status to the selected employee who has served the District for at least 15 years in a particular field of endeavor and shall be retiring at the end of the school year in which the title is bestowed.

Goal: To honor a District executive leader who has served the District with distinction for 24 years.

Comment: District Emeritus Status grants no special benefit or any payment of monies. This is an honorary title which may be used by the individual recognizing their past service.

Recommended Statement: After review of the Board policy requirements and the BOT Personnel Committee, it is recommended by the Chancellor that the Board approves the emeritus designation to Mr. C.M. Brahmbhatt as Vice Chancellor Emeritus of Administrative Services in honor of his 24 years of distinguished

service to the Coast Community College District.

14. Approve Independent Contractor Agreement with Cambridge West Partnership, LLC; Vision 2020 – Facilities Master Plan

1. Background:

Cambridge West Partnership, LLC will update the Facilities Master Plan as part of the District's overall vision plan - <u>Vision 2020</u>. The comprehensive plan is inclusive of two components as summarized below. An assessment, analysis, and projections will be completed for each site (Coastline, Golden West, Orange Coast, and District operations) and assembled into an overall District-wide Facilities Master Plan.

Component A: Development of the Facilities Master Plan

This component will translate the campus-specific vision and program projections set forth in the Educational Master Plan into the need for educational "space". In addition to the needs assessment through 2020, CWP will provide recommendations for sequencing and phasing of projects, estimation of project costs, and financing strategies.

Component B: Architectural Support for the Facilities Master Plan

The Facilities Master Plan will be supported by conceptual renderings that depict the locations of planned new construction, renovation, demolition, and site improvements. Where appropriate (substantial changes), architectural support will be graphically addressed. In other cases, conditions will be addressed via narratives.

2. Goal/Purpose:

To develop a Facilities Master Plan in support of the Educational Master Plan. This is part of the District's *Vision 2020* planning effort.

4. Recommendation Statement:

After review by the Vice Presidents of Administrative Services for Orange Coast College, Golden West College and Coastline College and Assistant Director of Facilities, Planning and Construction, it is recommended by the Chancellor that authorization be given to employ Cambridge West Partnership, LLC for an update

of the Facilities Master Plan as part of the District's overall vision plan – Vision 2020.

The scope of service is to include the following tasks:

Component A: Development of the Facilities Master Plan

Fees for Component A: \$78,200

Component B: Architectural Support for the Facilities Master Plan

Fees for Component B: \$67,500

It is further recommended that the President of the Board of Trustees, or designee, be authorized to sign the agreement.

Fiscal Impact: Not to Exceed \$145,700 (Capital Outlay Funds)

COAST COMMUNITY COLLEGE DISTRICT INTERIM ADMINISTRATOR EMPLOYMENT CONTRACT

- 1. <u>Parties.</u> The Coast Community College District ("'District'") and <u>Madjid</u>
 <u>Niroumand</u> ("Administrator") hereby enter into this Interim Administrator Employment
 Agreement ("Agreement"). District and Administrator are referred to herein individually as
 "Party" and collectively as "Parties."
- 2. <u>Position</u>. The District hereby employs Administrator as <u>Interim Associate</u> <u>Dean, Student Services</u>.
- 3. General Terms and Conditions of Employment. This Agreement is subject to all applicable laws of the State of California, the regulations of the Board of Governors of the California Community Colleges, and the rules, regulations, policies, and procedures of the District. These laws, rules, regulations, policies, and procedures, which may be amended, augmented, or repealed from time-to-time, are integrated into this Agreement.
- 4. <u>Duties and Responsibilities.</u> Administrator agrees to perform the duties, and accepts the responsibilities, of the position which may be delegated or assigned to Administrator by the Chancellor or the Board of Trustees.
- 5. <u>Term.</u> District agrees to employ Administrator, and Administrator agrees to serve, for the period commencing <u>10/7/10</u> and ending no later than <u>6/30/11</u>. This Agreement is not subject to automatic renewal pursuant to subsection "c" of Section 72411 of the *Education Code*.
- 6. Salary. Administrator shall be placed on the Academic Management Salary Schedule **DD** step **07**, range **26** (\$9,339.66 per month).
- 7. <u>Health and Welfare Benefits</u>. District shall provide Administrator with all health and welfare benefits that are granted to other District administrators.
- 8. <u>Expenses</u>. District shall reimburse Administrator for expenses incurred while performing official duties, pursuant to law and District policy.
- 9. **Evaluation.** Administrator shall be evaluated during the term of this Agreement, following procedures determined by the Chancellor and the Board of Trustees.
- 10. <u>Termination of Agreement</u>. The Agreement may be terminated by either Party without cause by providing the other Party with 30 days written notice.
- 11. **Prior Position.** If Administrator was employed by the District immediately prior to the commencement of this Agreement, then Administrator shall return to the prior position upon termination or expiration of this Agreement.
- 12. <u>Savings Clause</u>. If any provision of this Agreement is held to be contrary to law, all other provisions shall continue to remain in full force and effect.

- 13. Entire Agreement. This Agreement contains the entire agreement and understanding between the Parties. There are no terms, conditions, or oral understandings not contained in this Agreement.
- 14. <u>Amendment.</u> This Agreement may be modified or superseded only by a written amendment executed by both Parties.
