a. Student Success

- i) The success of our students is the number one priority district-wide. Numerous factors contribute to student success and this success can be defined in many different ways. Critical components in the array of strategies to support and enhance student success are the ongoing tracking and analysis of student success data and indicators and dialogue about these analyses to identify areas that need improvement and strategies that enhance student success. This report provides an analysis of student achievement for all three colleges with a focus on certificate completion rates, degree completion rates, transfer preparedness rates, and actual transfer rates. (See Attachment #3)
- ii) Community College Scoreboard: The Student Success Task Force recommended the implementation of a new accountability framework, whose purpose is to provide stakeholders with clear and concise information on key student progress and success metrics in order to improve performance. The recommendation specified that a scorecard be built on the existing reporting system, the Accountability Reporting for the Community Colleges (ARCC). The annual accountability report, now restructured as a scorecard, is due to the State Legislature and Governor's Office by March 31st and colleges have one year from that date to present the results from the scorecard to their local board of trustees. The attached document describes the framework for the revised annual accountability report and the college specific score card. (See Attachment #4)
