Chapter 5. Student Services

BP 5030 Fees – revision

Background: charging a "capital outlay fee" to non-resident students is not required by law. Sub-section "a" of *Education Code* Section 76141 provides that "In addition to the nonresident tuition fee established pursuant to Section 76140, a community college

district **may** charge to nonresident students” a capital outlay fee. (There are some students for which the District may *not* charge a capital outlay fee, as set forth in subsection “c” of *Education Code* Section 76141, namely, students who can demonstrate economic hardship, or who are a victim of persecution or discrimination in the country in which the student is a citizen and resident.) There is no legal prohibition against the District exempting certain students from the capital outlay fee. This revision is to specifically exempt from the capital outlay fee, starting in 2017-18, active duty military students and their dependents who either are enrolled in the Military Programs administered by Coastline Community College or who are enrolled only in fully online classes at any college in the District are exempt from this fee.
