For **Item 1.04 a. Conference with Legal Counsel Existing Litigation, California Department of Finance et al vs. Jan Grimes, Orange County Superior Court No. 30-2012-00559592-CU-WM-CJC**, on a motion by Trustee Grant, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted unanimously to approve the settlement agreement in California Department of Finance vs. Grimes litigation in which the District intervened and authorized the Chancellor to sign the settlement agreement on behalf of the Board. The Department of Finance, the State Chancellor's Office and the four community college districts in Orange County sued the Orange County Auditor Controller and the County Board of Supervisors after the Auditor Controller modified the method of calculating the County's Vehicle License Fee Adjustment amount for the 2011-2012 and the 2012-2013 Fiscal Years, thereby improperly withdrawing approximately \$150 million from the County's Educational Revenue Augmentation Fund for those years. The Orange County Superior Court ruled in favor of the districts and the DOF, concluding that the Auditor Controller's action was in violation of the law. In order to avoid further litigation and appeals, the parties have agreed to a settlement which provides for the County to repay the \$150 million over time by making payments to the County's Educational Augmentation Fund and through deposits into a separate account of the County Treasurer for the benefit of the California Community Colleges. Once all parties have signed the settlement agreement, a copy will be made available through the Chancellor's Office.

Dr. Serban stated that international students do not displace US students, in fact, to the contrary, through revenue generated they provide the opportunity to offer more sections and seats to US students. She added that as higher level achievement students academically than the overall student population, they have a positive impact on successful course completion rates, transfer statistics and overall GPA. The Board expressed their appreciation of the discussion and the report.
