22.07 DIS – Review and Approve Revisions to Vision 2020 Facilities Master Plan for Golden West College and Orange Coast College

College Presidents, Mr. Wes Bryan and Dr. Dennis Harkins, outlined amendments to the Vision 2020 Facilities Master Plan for Golden West College and Orange Coast College.

Mr. Bryan shared that the update to the Golden West College Facilities Master Plan took into consideration modifications that had been identified when the campus began the programming for the Criminal Justice Training Center. It had been quickly determined that the space the college had identified for this center in the Vision 2020 Facilities Master Plan would be insufficient for the program requirements and, after review, it had been determined that the site location would need to be moved to the south end of campus, creating a “domino effect”. The new plan took into consideration modifications necessary to meet the college facilities’ needs to allow for growth as well as updated, state-of-the-art facilities that would better serve the current and future students and faculty.

Mr. Bryan gave an overview of the new plan to the Board and in-depth discussion took place. Student traffic and parking were also discussed, including the impact of the new apartments on Gothard, and Mr. Bryan indicated that these issues were continuing to be looked at.

Dr. Harkins reported that the latest revision of the Orange Coast College Facilities Master Plan addressed the strategic planning and potential impacts related to the previous versions of the plan, with the current plan building from previous facilities plans, incorporating the feasibility studies and historical structure analysis performed over the past few years, and also reflecting feedback received through numerous community forum and outreach meetings.

Dr. Harkins reviewed the new plan with the Board, indicating that they had expanded the housing study, held meetings with the community, were looking at reissuing the CEQA document, and continued to work with the City of Costa Mesa. He added that they had listened to the community's concerns regarding traffic impact and historic structures and the plan had come from a collaborative process and was responsive to community needs, allowing for flexibility for building in the future. Dr. Harkins responded to Trustees' questions regarding the plan, including future plans for offsite parking. He indicated that they were in the process of looking at class scheduling that would alleviate some parking concerns.


