On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to approve Change Order No. 6, Orange Coast College Math, Business, Computing Center (MBCC), Bid No. 2020, and the Board President or designee, was authorized to sign any related documents, indicating approval by the Board of Trustees.

Background: In August 2013, the Board authorized contracts with nineteen (19) prime contractors to construct the Orange Coast College MBCC. As a whole, the nineteen prime contracts totaled \$35,035,648 for the complete construction of this project.

The project was completed and the college took occupancy of the building. The project team continued to work on making final adjustments to the building and closing out the contracts for all trades on the project.

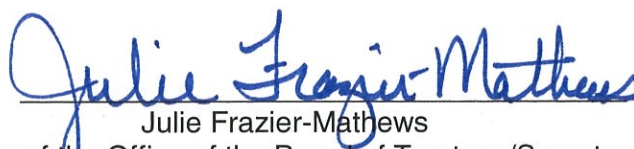
