21.01 DIS - Approval of Change Order No. 1 to Standard Professional Services Agreement with TYR, Inc. for Division of State Architect (DSA) Inspection Services; Golden West College Student Services Project

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Hornbuckle, the Board voted to approve Change Order No. 1 to the Standard Professional Services Agreement between TYR, Inc. and the Coast Community College District. The President of the Board of Trustees, or designee, was authorized to sign related documents, indicating approval by the Board of Trustees.

On October 1, 2014, the Board of Trustees approved the standard professional services agreement for TYR, Inc. in the amount of \$326,664 for DSA Inspection service for the new Golden West College Student Services Center. Approval of this amendment would ensure continued compliance with Title 24 construction regulations and the Division of State Architect approved construction

documents. This change order outlined additional fees for project inspection services due to additional DSA required inspections. This included a review of the finished exterior skin of the building as well as the completed covering up of the interior walls. Additionally, the installation of the fire sprinklers and an inspection of the new stairs would be completed.

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to approve Change Order No. 6 to the Standard Design Build Contract with Swinerton Builders. The Board President, or designee, was authorized to sign any related documents, indicating approval by the Board of Trustees.

On August 5, 2015, the Board authorized a standard design-build contract between Coast Community College District and Swinerton Builders for the design and construction of the Golden West College Criminal Justice Training Center. The project was currently in construction and expected to complete in Summer 2018. While working on underground utility connections it was determined that a water line that was assumed to be a 6 inch line was actually 3 inches. Upsizing this line would have required extensive underground work with an approximate cost of \$80,000. Alternatives were explored, and it was determined that establishing an alternate point of connection to an existing line in the parking lot would be the most cost effective solution.

Term: August 6, 2015 through June 30, 2018. This change order did not require any changes to the stipulated terms originally set forth in the Standard Design-Build Contract with Swinerton Builders.

Coastline Community College received a grant from the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office titled "**Safety Technician Career Pathways Apprenticeship Program (STCPAP)**." Coastline Community College is the lead college and fiscal agent for the STCPAP where project partners have offered curriculum maintained by the Occupational Safety Councils of America (OSCA) in response to increased demand for a skilled and agile workforce in the petrochemical and construction industries. Industry partners included ExxonMobil, Chevron, PSC Industrial Outsourcing, the Brock Group, and Transfield Services. Labor partners include Laborers International Union of North America Local 1309 and International Union of Painters and Allied Trades District Council 36A.

Original Board Date: March 16, 2016

Fiscal Impact: Coastline Community College would receive \$150,000 from January 21, 2016 to ~~February 1, 2017~~ June 30, 2017. No matching funds required.

Coastline Community College received a sub-grant from the Santa Clarita Community College District under the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office Innovation and Effectiveness Grant. Coastline Community College would use the grant funds to support enhancing four areas of focus: 1) guided pathways; 2) student learning outcomes; 3) internal communication; and 4) professional development infrastructure.

Fiscal Impact: Coastline Community College would receive \$200,000 from July 1, 2017 to June 30, 2018. No matching funds required.

Orange Coast College received a sub-grant from the Rancho Santiago Community College District under the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Strong

Workforce Program Regional Allocation for the “**Drone and Automation Technology**” regional project. OCC provides leadership and support among regional colleges to identify, refine and create programs that meet the needs of students and employers in the interrelated areas of drone engineering and automation technology.

Fiscal Impact: Orange Coast College would receive \$610,000 from July 1, 2016 to December 31, 2018. No matching funds required.
