### **18.00 Approval of Standard Agreements in Excess of \$88,300**

#### **18.01 DIS – Standard Amendment No. 1 to the Standard Professional Services Agreement with Willdan Geotechnical, a Division of Willdan Engineering**

## **19.00 Revenue Generating Agreements/Contracts Over \$88,300**

### **19.01 DIS – Funded Programs**

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to approve participation in the following funded programs and/or projects. In addition, associated contracts were approved.

**Coastline Community College** received an amendment from the Santa Clarita Community College District under the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office Innovation and Effectiveness Grant. The funding supported enhancing four areas of focus: 1) guided pathways; 2) student learning outcomes; 3) internal communication; and 4) professional development infrastructure. *This amendment extended the grant term end date from June 30, 2018 to June 3, 2019.*

**Fiscal Impact:** Coastline Community College would receive \$200,000 from July 1, 2017 to ~~June 30, 2018~~ June 3, 2019. No matching funds required.

**Original Board Date:** July 19, 2017

**Coastline Community College** received a grant from the National Security Agency (NSA) titled, "**Department of Defense (DoD)**

**Information Assurance Scholarship Program (IASP) Cybersecurity Workforce Education."** The project focused on the review of cyber pathway models and the development and adoption of K-12 cyber pathways that were offered with a community college partner. The project would bring faculty and instructors together to develop pathways, including best practices and implementation strategies. Anticipated project goals included: 1) review cybersecurity K-12 pathway models that were being discussed by western states; 2) participation in discussions regarding cybersecurity K-12 pathways with the California Department of Education and faculty/instructors in the field; 3) development of a K-12 pathway that aligned with the Center for Academic Excellence post-secondary designation knowledge units outlined by the NSA; 4) ensuring alignment and transfer options for the K-12 cybersecurity pathway; and 5) dissemination of project deliverables at conferences and workshops.



**Fiscal Impact:** Coastline Community College will receive \$214,983 from September 26, 2017 to September 25, 2018. No matching funds required.

**Coastline Community College** received additional funding from the Department of Defense/National Security Agency under the 2017 Center of Academic Excellence (CAE)-Cyber Defense (CD) National and Regional Resource Centers working with colleges and universities in the Western Region of the United States to provide assistance in the CAE program development and application process for non-CAE institutions and helping current CAE institutions to further develop their programs. The Board approved to enter into an agreement with the Department of Defense/National Security Agency to receive \$100,000 from January 1, 2017 to January 1, 2018 at the August 2, 2017 Board meeting.

**Fiscal Impact:** Coastline Community College would receive \$89,140.92 from September 15, 2017 to September 14, 2018. No matching funds required.

## **20.00 Ratification/Approval of General Items of Business**

### **20.01 DIS - Approval of Standard Architectural Services Agreement for the Orange Coast College Language and Social Science Building Complex Project, RFP 2114**

On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted to approve the Standard Architectural Services Agreement between tBP Architecture and Coast Community College District. Orange Coast College's master plan included the new construction of an estimated 108,000 square foot complex, to be built adjacent to the new Math, Business, and Computer Science Building Complex. This new facility would replace the existing language arts, social sciences, and humanities buildings located elsewhere on campus. It was anticipated that construction on this project would commence on or about August of 2019 and be completed by April 2021.

On August 4, 2017 the District issued RFP #2114, seeking qualified architectural/engineering to provide professional design services for the pre-design, design, bidding, construction, and post-construction phases of the Orange Coast College Language Arts and Social Sciences Building Complex. The District published this advertisement two consecutive weeks in the Daily Pilot. In addition, the District sent a direct announcement to 963 firms on our internal notification list

and published the announcement on the District's website. The District received proposals from 16 firms. A selection committee was convened, consisting of Orange Coast College and District office personnel to review and evaluate all respondents. Respondents were evaluated and scored based on (1) approach to the project and management plan, (2) experience of the team proposed (3) cost (4) depth and relevance of the team's experience, (5) references, (6) overall firm capability and resources, and (7) the team's overall understanding of the project. Based on the initial scoring, the following three firms were short-listed and invited to participate in the interview phase. The finalists included:

1. Gensler
2. tBP Architecture
3. HMC

Interviews were held on September 15, 2017 and September 19, 2017 at which time, the committee, after extensive deliberations, recommended the selection of tBP Architecture for this project.

The following respondents (alphabetical) were not selected as finalists for this project: HED, JFAK, Johnson Favaro, Lionakis, LPA, HPI, PBK, Perkins Eastman, QDG, RNT, SVA Architects, Westberg + White

**Fiscal Impact:** \$3,652,590. The breakdown of which is as follows:

Architectural/Engineering Services: \$3,537,590  
Consulting and Contract Management for Fixed Furniture and Assets  
Procurement: \$95,000  
Reimbursable Expenses: \$20,000

In his 2017-18 Fiscal Year budget, the governor approved Orange Coast College's Final Project Proposal for the Language Arts and Social Sciences Building Complex, allocating \$31,221,000 in state funds towards this project. A portion of these State Capital Outlay Funds as well as General Obligation Measure M Bond Funds will be used to fund these services.

## **20.02 DIS – Authorization to Purchase Storage from Pricon Enterprise Technologies Utilizing NASPO Contract # MNNVP-134 Price Agreement**

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to grant authorization for the District to purchase storage from Pricon Enterprise Technologies using NASPO Contract # MNNVP-134, having determined that this arrangement was in the District's best interest. The Board President or designee, was authorized to sign any related documents, indicating approval by the Board of Trustees.

The consolidation of the Orange Coast College (OCC) Data Center into the Coast Community College District (CCCD) Data Center required additional storage capacity to complete. The OCC consolidation into the CCCD Data Center would complete the vision of centralizing primary IT Infrastructure into a single site to facilitate increased proficiencies and lower yearly operating costs. As such, purchasing additional storage through Pricon Enterprise Technologies would expeditiously facilitate the completion of this Data Center consolidation. In addition, after receiving and reviewing multiple quotes for this storage expansion, the recommended purchase was the most cost effective.

The goal of this procurement was to upgrade and consolidate to the District Office Data Center to provide a more resilient, stable, scalable, flexible and cost effective environment. Pricon Enterprise Technologies had been in business for 28 years as an authorized HP/Cisco/VMware reseller and adhered to NASPO Contract pricing for all manufacturers. Public Contract Code 20652 provides authority for the Board of Trustees of any community college district without advertising for bids, to use other Public Agencies' contracts for lease or purchase of equipment when the Board of Trustees has determined it to be the best value to the District.

**Fiscal Impact:** Not to exceed \$168,073.95 to be paid for from Measure M General Obligation Bond Funds.
