Chancellor Weispfenning introduced and welcomed Miles Nevin, District Director of Chancellor's Office Operations and Projects who would begin in April.

Dr. Weispfenning provided a status update on the Chancellor's Goals for the District 2017-19 which responded to item #2 on the Board Directives Log. He addressed questions and comments from the Trustees. Trustee Patterson requested additional information relative to social media marketing efforts, guided pathway initiative progress, improvements to student services, the use of predictive analytics to enhance student success, Trustee Moreno requested the inclusion of "identify and remove barriers to admission, financial

aid and enrollment" in Goal #1 Grow Enrollments. The Board commended the Chancellor for the report and progress made.

Vice Chancellor of Finance and Administrative Services, Dr. Andy Dunn and Senior Director of Facilities, Planning and Construction, Jerry Marchbank presented four recommendations to the Board:

- 1. Increase local bidder pool
- 2. Increase local participation scoring for bid prequalification
- 3. Include 10% local hire component in all requests for qualification/proposal
- 4. Revisions to Board Policy and Administrative Procedure

On August 3, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 5-Structural Steel and Miscellaneous Metals, to Anderson Charnesky Structural Steel for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$139,000 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$45,738 to the General Obligation Bond.

18.02 DIS - Approval of Amendment No. 1 to Standard Contractor Services Agreement with Inland Building Construction Companies

On June 15, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 15-Elevators, to Inland Building Construction Companies for construction services on the Student Services Center Project at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$40,000 in allowances, none of which was used during this project.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$40,400 to the General Obligation Bond.

18.03 DIS - Approval of Amendment No. 1 to Standard Contractor Services Agreement with Caston, Inc.

On June 15, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 10-Metal Frames, Drywall, Insulation, Fireproofing, Fire Stopping and Weather Barrier, to Caston, Inc. Also awarded to Caston, Inc., on the same meeting date in June, was Bid Package No 12- Plaster. Both bid packages procured construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$161,500 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$64,513 to the General Obligation Bond.

18.04 DIS - Approval of Amendment No. 1 to Standard Contractor Services Agreement with Performance Contracting, Inc.

On June 16, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 11-Terracotta Rain-Screen, to Performance Contracting, Inc. for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$23,000 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$17,606 to the General Obligation Bond.

18.05 DIS - Approval of Amendment No. 1 to Standard Contractor Services Agreement with JM Farnan Co, Inc.

On June 16, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 21-Plumbing, to JM Farnan Co, Inc. for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$48,000 in allowances, none of which was used during the construction.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$48,480 to the General Obligation Bond.

18.06 DIS - Approval of Amendment No. 1 to the Standard Contractor Agreement with MS Rouse Co.

On June 16, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 17B-Flooring, to MS Rouse Co. for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$25,000 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$77,571 to the General Obligation Bond.

18.07 DIS - Approval of Amendment No. 1 to Standard Contractor Services Agreement with Crew, Inc.

On June 15, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 25-Earthwork, to Crew, Inc. for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$250,000 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$155,785 to the General Obligation Bond.

On June 16, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 16-Signage, to Inland Building Companies, Inc. for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$18,000 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$2,209 to the General Obligation Bond.

On June 16, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 8-Doors, Frames and Hardware, to Montgomery Hardware Co., Inc. for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$47,500 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$35,867 to the General Obligation Bond.

On June 16, 2016 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2063, Bid Package 19-Specialties, to Inland Building Companies, Inc. for construction services on the Student Services Center at Golden West College. The original bid amount included \$35,000 in allowances to cover costs during construction such as unforeseen conditions, design omissions, trade damage and owner changes.

Fiscal Impact: A credit of \$33,488 to the General Obligation Bond.

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Patterson, the Board voted to approve Amendment No. 1 to the Standard Construction Manager Services Agreement with C.W. Driver.

On March 15, 2017 the Board of Trustees awarded Bid No. 2102 to C.W. Driver to provide construction management services on the Orange Coast College Student Union Project. The scope of the project had grown to include a pre-demolition phase to reroute the existing utilities and network infrastructure. This allowed the construction of the new building to begin without interfering with the utilities and network infrastructure supporting the existing buildings on campus. This additional scope required the construction manager to prepare a separate bid package for these pre-demolition services as well as to extend their services to oversee the construction once the contract had been awarded.

Fiscal Impact: \$126,726 paid utilizing General Obligation Bond Funds designated for the Orange Coast College Student Union Project.

Original Project Contract Amount: \$4,095,727

Total Project Change Orders: \$126,726 (3.09% Increase)

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to approve Amendment No. 2 to the Standard Architectural Services Agreement with Little Diversified Architectural Consulting.

On January 18, 2017 the Board approved the standard architectural services agreement with Little Diversified Architectural Consulting to procure design services for the Orange Coast College Adaptive PE, Gym and Pool Renovation Project. The original scope of work did not include services for the preparation of Storm Water Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) or Notice of Intent (NOI) documents for filing with the State Water Resources Control Board. The development of these plans ultimately aided in obtaining the necessary permits to begin construction of this project. Approval of Amendment No. 2 to the standard architectural services agreement included additional services as described above along with the development of a Water Quality Management Plan, all insuring compliance with State regulations.

Fiscal Impact: \$22,500. The previous contract amount was \$2,272,725, bringing the new contract total to \$2,295,225. General Obligation Measure M Bond Funds designated for the Orange Coast College Adaptive PE, Gym and Pool Renovation Project.
