# 1.04 DIS - Bid Tabulations and Award of Contract for Contractor Services for Orange Coast College East Campus Utility Relocation Package B - Electric, Bid 2122R

On a motion by Trustee Patterson, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to award Bid No. 2122R to Mel Smith Electric and authorize the President of the Board of Trustees, or designee to sign any related documents.

Orange Coast College sought contractor services to relocate the existing sewer, domestic water, gas, electrical, fiber optic communication, and site lighting in preparation for the new Student Union project. The bid was advertised in two packages: Package A was scoped to include the relocation of the existing utilities, while Package B included the relocation of the electrical and communications. It was anticipated that the project would commence on June 1, 2018 and be completed by August 13, 2018.

No responses were received for the scope of work detailed in Package B, electrical/communications. The telecommunications piece of Package B was removed from the scope, and the project was rebid with a two-week advertisement in the Daily Pilot

as well as mass notification to 306 vendors utilizing the PlanetBids portal. Four bids were received and opened on May 10, 2018.
