19.06 DIS - Bid Tabulations and Award of Contract for Construction Management Services for Orange Coast College Professional Mariner Training Center, RFP No. 2124

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to award RFP No. 2124 to TELACU Construction Management.

Orange Coast College sought construction management services for the Professional Mariner Training Center. This included management through the pre-construction, bidding, construction, and post-construction phases of the new construction of a second level classroom building, with ground parking beneath as well as the new construction of a covered galvanized steel pedestrian bridge spanning across Pacific Coast Highway. Construction was expected to begin in October 2018 with a completion date estimated in December 2020.

Notices were published in the Daily Pilot on May 2, 2018 and May 9, 2018. Additionally, 486 vendors were notified via the PlanetBids portal. Forty-one perspective bidders reviewed the bid requirements, and five bids were received and opened on May 23, 2018.

The District Purchasing office established a selection committee, consisting of OCC and District office personnel to review and evaluate all respondents. Respondents were evaluated and scored based on (1) depth and relevance of experience related to this project (2) approach to the project and management plan, (3) experience of the team proposed (4) cost (5) local business participation, (6) references, (7) understanding of project and strengths, (8) overall firm capability and resources.

Based on the initial scoring, three firms were short-listed and invited to participate in the interview phase. Interviews were held on June 29, 2018 and July 13, 2018 at which time the committee, after extensive deliberations, recommended TELACU for selection of for this project. The interviewees included:

19.07 DIS - Bid Tabulations and Award of Contracts for Orange Coast College Student Union Project- Bid No. 2119

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted to award the Standard Contractor Services Agreements for Bid No. 2119 to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for Bid Packages 1, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7, 8, 9, 10,12, 13, 14, 18, 20, 21, 22, 23, and 24.

Orange Coast College planned to construct a new 119,000 square foot, three-story College Center building and a new 40,600 square foot, two-story Student Life building. This project would include the demolition of the existing Student Center and the renovation of the existing Administration Building. The project would be procured via Multiple Prime Contracts to the District with C.W. Driver acting as the District's Construction Manager. The anticipated Construction schedule was from August 2018 to January 2021.

Notices were published in the Daily Pilot on March 9, 2018 and March 16, 2018 notifying potential bidders of the prequalification opportunity.
