20.01 DIS - Amendment No. 1 to the Standard Construction Management Agreement with Kitchell, CEM

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Grant, the Board voted to approve Amendment No. 1 to the Standard Construction Management Agreement with Kitchell, CEM.

At the regular meeting of the Board of Trustees on January 20, 2016, the Board awarded RFP 2074 to Kitchell CEM for construction management services on the Orange Coast College Planetarium Project. This agreement provided funding authorization for construction phase services through February 1, 2018. Delays in the original schedule resulted in an extended construction phase for the project. Approval of Amendment No. 1 maintained construction management services through construction and project close out. This amendment provided authorization for continued construction phase services through February 9, 2019, and Coast District would only compensate Kitchell for the actual services performed on the project.

20.02 DIS - Change Order No. 9 to Standard Design Build Contract with Swinerton Builders; Golden West College Criminal Justice Training Center; RFQ 2043

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Patterson, the Board voted to approve Change Order No. 9 to the Standard Design Build Contract with Swinerton Builders and that the Board President, or designee, be authorized to sign any related documents, indicating approval by the Board of Trustees.

On August 5, 2015, the Board authorized a design-build contract between Coast Community College District and Swinerton Builders for the design and construction of the Golden West College Criminal Justice Training Center. Change Order No. 9 was the final change order required to complete financial close out of the project. Following approval of the final change order the project closed approximately \$77,000 under the originally estimated budget.

Change Order No. 9 reconciled several additive and deductive change orders for the project, including utility and audio visual changes, ADA path of travel changes, and an adjustment to the building footprint effectively increasing the outdoor training space.

Orange Coast College, in partnership with the developer Servitas, began construction on a new Student Housing Project. This project broke ground in early October 2018 with an estimated completion and occupancy in August 2020.

To ensure compliance with Title 24 construction regulations and Division of State Architect approved construction documents, Orange Coast College utilized the services of UCMI during the construction of the Student Housing Project. The Division of State Architect required that the Inspector of Record be directly contracted by the Coast Community College District. All expenses incurred as a result of services would be reimbursed by the project developer.

The pdf catalogs formerly produced had limitation in terms of ADA compliance and ease of search. CourseLeaf Catalog was designed to manage processes for colleges by incorporating flexible workflows with easy data entry and integration and editing capabilities. CourseLeaf Catalog integrated with Banner and DegreeWorks to automatically populate the online catalog with the current courses. In addition, CourseLeaf Catalog integrated with the District's authentication system. The result was an accurate, dynamic and searchable academic catalog website that met web and ADA standards while matching the style and graphics of each institution.

Orange Coast College constructed a new 119,000 square foot three-story College Center building and a new 40,600 square foot two-story Student Life building. The project included the demolition of the existing Student Center and the renovation of the existing Administration Building. The project was procured via Multiple Prime Contracts to the District with C.W. Driver acting as the District's Construction Manager. The anticipated Construction schedule was from August 2018 to January 2021.

Notices were published in the Daily Pilot on March 9, 2018 and March 16, 2018 notifying potential bidders of the prequalification opportunity. In addition, notices of this pre-qualification were sent to 789 potential bidders via the direct bid notification system through the Planet Bids Portal. One hundred ninety-nine prequalification applications were submitted of which one hundred forty bidders were pre-qualified. Fifty-Six bids were received and opened on July 20, 2018.

No bids were received for five of the twenty-four advertised packages, resulting in the rebidding of five bid packages. The advertisement for Bid 2119R was sent to fourteen pre-qualified vendors using the PlanetBids portal on August 17, 2018. Nine bids were received and opened on September 5, 2018.


