The Community College League of California (CCLC) was partnering with Assemblymember Chris Holden to advance Assembly Bill 30, Community College: College and Career Access Pathways Partnerships.

This bill ensured access to early college opportunities remained available to all California students by preventing key statutes from sun-setting. AB 30 recognized the importance of enabling innovative partnerships between K-12 districts and community colleges so that college access was ubiquitous and not exclusive. More importantly, AB 30 was a step

towards eliminating opportunity gaps for students underrepresented in higher education. AB 30 was scheduled to go before the Assembly Higher Education Committee on Tuesday, March 5, 2019.

20.01 DIS - Amendment No. 2 to the Standard Professional Services Agreement with GeoCon West, Inc.

GeoCon West, Inc. was contracted to provide geotechnical inspection and reporting services for the Orange Coast College Student Union Project. Since then, excessive rains in the months of December 2018 and January 2019 required significant portions of the project to be re-done or rebuilt. As a result, additional inspection services were required to monitor and review these required rebuilds. Additional funding would replace the services that were utilized during these unforeseen conditions and allow for services to continue, uninterrupted, through construction completion.

Term: July 1, 2018 – February 28, 2021 (no change)

Fiscal Impact: Add \$30,000 for a contract total of \$118,500 to be paid using General Obligation Measure M Bond Funds. This was a not to exceed amount paid at varying rates of pay depending upon the service provided.

21.01 DIS - Funded Programs

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Hornbuckle, the Board approved participation in the following funded programs, and approved the associated contracts or amendments.

Coastline Community College received a grant from the California Department of Education, Adult Education Office funded through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title II: Adult Education Family Literacy Act, Section 231. This grant provided supplemental funds for adult education to 1) assist adults to become literate and obtain the knowledge and skills necessary for employment and economic self-sufficiency; 2) assist adults who were parents or family members to obtain education and skills; 3) assist adults in attaining a secondary school diploma and postsecondary education and training, including career pathways; and 4) assist immigrants and other individuals who were English language learners.

Fiscal Impact: Coastline Community College would receive \$94,124 from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019. Minimum of 25% match required. The match was provided in-kind.

Golden West College received the first amendment to a grant from the State Chancellor's Office titled "Orange County Deputy Sector Navigator for Health." The Deputy Sector Navigator facilitates collaboration in the health occupations sector, brings together education and industry partners to achieve the goals of the Economic and Workforce Development Program. The amendment was related to payment and invoicing as follows: Advanced payment of 40% to Golden West College after the Agreement was fully executed, a progress payment of 50%, and a final payment of 10%. Payments would occur through submission of invoices.

22.02 DIS - Amendment No. 1 to the Non-Standard Agreement with WTC Consulting, Inc.

On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted to approve Amendment #1 to the Non-Standard Agreement with WTC Consulting, Inc.

On November 15, 2017, the Board approved WTC Consulting, Inc. to assess and establish the Technology Condition Index (TCI) of our District. Phase I of the project provided Coast with data for the calculation of the Total Cost of Ownership (TCO) for future technology planning and purchases. With the completion of their Phase I, WTC created an index and provided the District with:

- The complete inventory of primary and application specific network elements in use at all District sites.
- The foundational data needed to prioritize device replacement based on usage, role and condition of the devices.

On April 18, 2018, the Board approved Coast to re-engage with WTC to complete the Technology and Facility Sustainability Planning Project for the District that would include Phases II and III. The outcomes included:

- Alignment of Coast Strategic Technology Plan with Procurement and Funding The
 plan would roadmap the process to support the acquisition, implementation and
 sustainment of the tools needed to support instruction and the overall business of the
 District on a long-term basis.
- A unified TCO Model for Technology and Facilities The model would focus on the
 phasing of costs for major systems and infrastructure, encompassing the appropriate
 lifecycle of the assets. This coupled with existing TCI and Facilities Master Plan would
 provide a holistic planning process for Coast. A budgetary timing-of-funds model
 reflecting these planned expenditures would provide the pathway for sustainability of
 critical technical systems in the District.

At this time, there was a need to amend our current agreement with WTC to increase the contract amount by \$30,000 and extend the end date of the engagement from October 12, 2018 to March 15, 2019. Over the course of their work, WTC encountered some difficulty obtaining vital cost information needed to complete Phases II and III. This Amendment covered the additional time and effort needed to complete their work on the Technology Infrastructure Plan and Roadmap engagement.

Term: June 8, 2018 – March 15, 2019

Fiscal Impact: Increase of \$30,000 to the original contract amount of \$220,000. New contract total not to exceed \$250,000 to be paid for using Capital Outlay Funds.

The Coast Community College District sought to lower overall costs of banking services for the District, campuses, Foundations, Enterprise, and student groups that require banking services. The District sought qualified financial institutions interested in providing a complete program for the District's banking needs. This program included banking and related depository services, as well as cash management services. The selected financial institution had clearly demonstrated their relevant experience and expertise as it relates to State of California public sector banking laws and regulations and would provide comprehensive banking services for the District and its campuses.

Notices were published in the Daily Pilot on May 25, 2018 and June 1, 2018. Additionally, 146 vendors were notified via the PlanetBids portal. Twenty-three bidders reviewed the proposal requirements, and four proposals were received and opened on July 30, 2018. The District Purchasing office established a selection committee consisting of the Executive Director District Fiscal Affairs, District Controller, and the Fiscal Director of each campus, to review and evaluate all respondents. Respondents were evaluated and scored based on (1) proper submission of proposal, (2) comprehensiveness of services to be provided, (3) public sector experience and resources, (4) assigned relationship manager or team, (5) overall cost to District, (6) service enhancements, and (7) local business participation.

The four firms were invited to participate in the interview phase. Interviews were held on September 6, 2018 at which time the committee, after extensive deliberations, recommended East West Bank, for selection for this project. The interviewees were:
