### **3.02 DIS - ACCJC Reaffirmation of Accreditation for Coastline College, Golden West College and Orange Coast College**

On June 28, 2019, the colleges received letters concluding the comprehensive evaluation process from the Accrediting Commission for Community and Junior Colleges (ACCJC). All three colleges had their accreditation reaffirmed for seven years, the maximum possible under the ACCJC policy. Accreditation was the process for accountability and continuous improvement that included self-evaluation and external peer review. Accredited status was necessary for institutions of higher education to be eligible to participate in federal financial aid programs.

**19.02 DIS - Amendment #1 to the Standard Independent Contractor Agreement with Fallen Leaf Films**

On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Student Trustee Finkbeiner, the Board voted to approve Amendment #1 to the Standard Independent Contractor Agreement with Fallen Leaf Films.

Coast Community College District led the development of interactive geographic information system story maps and web map applications to promote regional career pathways. Fallen Leaf Films provided additional services for video deliverables, including Spanish language captioning and updated logos required by the re-branding implemented by the State Chancellor's Office Workforce and Economic Development Division. Amendment #1 was to increase the total amount from \$116,550 to \$120,550 and change the end date from June 8, 2019 to July 31, 2019. Prior Board action was on August 1, 2018.

**19.03 DIS - Standard Professional Services Agreement with Cloud Professional Services**

On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Student Trustee Finkbeiner, the Board voted to approve the Professional Services Agreement with Cloud Professional Services.

In June of 2018, the Board approved the District Information Services (DIS) Team to complete Phase 1 of the Telephony Modernization Project by transitioning from a 28-year-old analog telephone system to a Voice over Internet Protocol (VoIP) Infrastructure that supports a 21st Century modern communication system. Phase 1 of the VoIP Telephony Project was successfully completed over the 2018 Summer semester. The district continued to Phase 2 of the project with the support of Cloud Professional Services whose primary responsibility was to assist Coast with the architect, design and implementation of critical Phase 2 tasks. This included decommissioning all landline (analog) fax machines, converting emergency code blue telephones in campus parking lots to new cloud VoIP solutions which would significantly reduce the colleges requirements for copper cabling distribution infrastructure.

## **21.00 Revenue Generating Agreements/Contracts Over \$90,200**

### **21.01 DIS - Funded Programs**

On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Trustee Grant, the Board voted to approve participation in the funded programs outlined below. The associated contracts or amendments to previously approved contracts were approved.

**Coastline Community College** received a grant from the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office titled "Currently and Formerly Incarcerated Student Reentry Program." The funds were used to establish and provide support programs for formerly incarcerated students enrolled at the college or to provide face-to-face instruction to students in prison or jail. Coastline focused on the students' reentry into their communities through support programs such as academic success coaching, peer mentoring, academic success workshops, personal success workshops, and financial literacy.

**Fiscal Impact:** Coastline Community College received \$113,636 from July 1, 2019 to December 31, 2021. No matching funds required.

**Golden West College** received a revised participation agreement for the Strong Workforce Program Regional Projects 2017-18 funding to increase the total amount of the agreement by \$44,807 to a total of \$316,025. The increase included the Allied Health Sector to cover the cost of the simulator.

**Fiscal Impact:** Golden West College received \$316,025 from July 1, 2017 to December 31, 2019. No matching funds required.

**Golden West College** received Amendment 02 from California State University Fullerton to the subaward agreement for Project RAISE: Regional Alliance in STEM Education. Project RAISE provided a variety of services and administered projects to increase the number of Hispanic and low-income STEM students and the persistence, retention, and graduation rates among participants. Amendment 02 approved using \$20,108 unspent carry over funds from Year 2 of the grant and added Year 3 funding in the amount of \$20,000.

**Fiscal Impact:** Golden West College received \$100,000 from October 1, 2016 to September 30, 2021. No matching funds required.

**Orange Coast College** received Amendment 02 for the California Department of Education, Child Development Division grant titled "Harry & Grace Steele Children's Center California State Preschool Program Grant (CSPP-8339)." The Children's Center received funds to subsidize childcare for low-income student-parents since 1978. The

funding provided child care services for preschool children ages 3-5 years of low-income students enrolled in a minimum of 6 units while attending Orange Coast College, Golden West College or Coastline Community College. The amendment increased the amount of the contract from \$177,822 to \$258,368 to cover additional children served.

**Fiscal Impact:** Orange Coast College received \$177,882 \$258,368 from July 1, 2018 to June 30, 2019. No matching funds required.

**Prior Board Actions:** June 20, 2018, December 12, 2018

**Orange Coast College** received a renewal for the California Department of Education, Child Development Division grant titled "Harry & Grace Steele Children's Center California State Preschool Program Grant (CSPP-9340)." The Children's Center received funds to subsidize childcare for low-income student-parents since 1978. The funding provided child care services for preschool children ages 3-5 years of low-income students enrolled in a minimum of 6 units while attending Orange Coast College, Golden West College or Coastline Community College. Associated resolution #19-31 was required as part of the grant.

**Fiscal Impact:** Orange Coast College received \$177,882 from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020. No matching funds required.

**Orange Coast College** received a renewal for the California Department of Education, Child Development Division grant titled, "Harry & Grace Steel Children's Center General Child Care & Development Program Grant (CCTR-9157)." The Children's Center received funds to subsidize childcare for low-income student-parents since 1978. The funding provides child care services for infants and toddlers of low-income students enrolled in a minimum of 6 units while attending Orange Coast College, Golden West College or Coastline Community College. Associated resolution #19-32 was required as part of the grant.

**Fiscal Impact:** Orange Coast College received \$318,726 from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020. No matching funds required.

On February 21, 2019, February 28, 2019, and April 12, 2019, three Governor's Proclamations were issued to secure funding to help local jurisdictions respond to and recover from the Mid-February 2019 Storms. The Mid-February 2019 Storms incident made available California Disaster Assistance Act (CDAA) funding for eligible counties, including Orange County.

For Coast Community College District, there were damages caused by the Mid-February Storms incident, which prompted the Risk Services department and Campus Public Safety departments to seek out funding to help recover losses. To be eligible and apply for State assistance, authorized agents were designated by Coast Community College District's Governing Body (Board of Trustees). Authorized agents of Coast Community College District would be eligible to apply for State assistance for a period of three years upon the date of approval for all open and future disasters.

Director of Risk Services Kevin Pegg provided a brief summary of the application process and funding timeline to the Board.

It was later discovered that the "Eko3" filters were a relatively new product to the marketplace and were experiencing issues on new installations. Thus, the team researched several options, including the "EPD" Filter Systems as an alternative. The Project Team concluded that the "EPD" Filter systems are the most appropriate for the Project in terms of function, cost, durability, maintenance and manufacturer support.


