## **2.06 DIS - Informational Report on Measure M Bond Issuance and Refunding**

On November 6, 2012, the voters of the District approved Measure M, which authorized the issuance of up to \$698,000,000 of general obligation bonds to construct, modernize and equip District facilities. The District had previously sold five series of Bonds under Measure M.

At the August 21, 2019 meeting of the Board of Trustees, staff provided an informational report addressing the final bond issuance (2019 Series F) and a refunding opportunity (2019 Refunding) on a prior issuance under the Measure M General Obligation (GO) Bond Program. The Board was presented with three options with respect to the Series F issuance including 1) Capital Appreciation Bonds (CAB's) rather than Current Interest Bonds (CIB's), 2) Relaxing the \$17.97/\$100,000 tax rate, and 3) aggregating the tax rate from both Measure C and M. Staff recommended Option #1, which would allow the District a timely last issuance, while maintaining the \$17.97 tax rate pledge to the community.

Consistent with the provisions enacted by California Assembly Bill 182 ("AB 182"), the Resolution and materials presented (2019 Series F Bonds) were publicly noticed as an information item at the October 2, 2019 Board meeting. At the October 23, 2019 meeting, being the Board's next consecutive meeting, the attached Resolution and materials pertaining to the 2019 Series F Bonds would be publicly noticed as an action item for consideration by the Board. As required by AB 182, appended to the Resolution as Exhibit B was the following information provided by PFM Financial Advisors, LLC, the municipal advisor to the District: (i) approximations of the financing term of the Series F Bonds; (ii) time of maturity of the Series F Bonds; (iii) the repayment ratio of the Series F Bonds; (iv) estimated change in assessed value of taxable property within the District over the term of the Series F Bonds; (v) an analysis containing the total overall cost of the capital appreciation bonds expected to be issued; (vi) a comparison between the overall cost of the capital appreciation bonds expected to be issued and the overall cost of current interest bonds; (vii) and the reason that capital appreciation bonds were being recommended.

At the meeting of October 23, 2019, the Board would be presented with a resolution to approve the 2019 Refunding Bonds.

#### **20.01 DIS - Standard Professional Services Agreement with Willdan Engineering**

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Student Trustee Finkbeiner, the Board voted to approve the Standard Professional Services Agreement with Willdan Engineering.

As part of the Vision 2020 Facilities Master Plan, and after being awarded partial state funding for the project, Orange Coast College began construction on a new Language Arts and Social Sciences facility.

To ensure compliance with Title 24 construction regulations, ensure structural safety, and to assure long term structural viability, Orange Coast College sought authorization to utilize the services of Willdan Geotechnical during the construction of the Language Arts and Social Sciences facility. Willdan Geotechnical provided material testing and inspection services through the duration of the project, contracting directly with the Coast Community College District.

**Term:** October 3, 2019 - June 1, 2021

**Fiscal Impact:** Not to exceed \$200,124. Compensation rates based on the type of inspection services performed. Costs split between General Obligation Measure M Bond Funds & State Proposition 51 Funds.

**20.03 DIS - Amendment No. 1 to Standard Agreement for Construction Management Services with C.W. Driver, LLC for Orange Coast College Language Arts & Social Sciences Building**

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Grant, the Board voted to approve Amendment No. 1 to the Standard Construction Management Agreement with C.W. Driver, LLC for the Orange Coast College Language Arts & Social Sciences Building, and authorized the President of the Board of Trustees, or designee to sign any related documents indicating approval by the Board of Trustees.

In March 2019, the Board of Trustees authorized a construction management services agreement for the Orange Coast College Language Arts & Social Sciences Building. Due to the project being partially State-funded, the District was only authorized to proceed with pre-construction services until the State approved commencement of construction. It was

indicated at that time, that the contract would be amended to reflect the continuing phases of work. On August 26, 2019, the State approved the District to proceed with construction of this project. The amendment sought authorization for continuing construction management services during the next phase of the project.

**Coastline College** received a grant from the California Department of Education, Adult Education Office funded through the Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title II: Adult Education Family Literacy Act, Section 231. This grant provided supplemental funds for adult education to 1) assist adults to become literate and obtain the knowledge and skills necessary for employment and economic self-sufficiency; 2) assist adults who are parents or family members to obtain education and skills; 3) assist adults in attaining a secondary school diploma and postsecondary education and training, including career pathways; and 4) assist immigrants and other individuals who are English language learners.

**Fiscal Impact:** Coastline College received \$109,945 from July 1, 2019 to June 30, 2020. Minimum of 25% match required. Match provided in kind.

**Golden West College** received a renewal grant sub-agreement from Rancho Santiago Community College District which functions as the fiscal agent for the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office grant titled "Key Talent Administration and Sector Strategy." The purpose of this grant sub-agreement was for Golden West College to host and supervise the Orange County Regional Director for Health (formerly called Deputy Sector Navigator for Health). The Regional Director facilitated collaboration in the health occupations sector and brought together education and industry partners to achieve the goals of the Economic and Workforce Development Program.

**Fiscal Impact:** Golden West College received \$200,000 from July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020. Matching funds of \$200,000 were required. Sources of matching funds were industry match for the Nursing/Allied Health Faculty Development, Nursing Staff Development, and HWI and Regional Advisory meetings.

**Golden West College** received a renewal grant sub-agreement from Rancho Santiago Community College District which functions as the fiscal agent for the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office grant titled "Key Talent Administration and Sector Strategy." The purpose of this grant sub-agreement was for Golden West College to host and supervise the Orange County Regional Director for Advanced Transportation and Logistics (formerly called Deputy Sector Navigator for Advanced Transportation and Logistics). The Regional Director facilitated collaboration in the advanced transportation and logistics occupations sector and brought together education and industry partners to achieve the goals of the Economic and Workforce Development Program.

**Fiscal Impact:** Golden West College received \$200,000 from July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020. Matching funds of \$200,000 were required. Sources of matching funds were industry and college in kind match.

**Orange Coast College** received a renewal grant sub-agreement from Rancho Santiago Community College District which functions as the fiscal agent for the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office grant titled "Key Talent Administration and Sector Strategy." The purpose of this grant sub-agreement was for Orange Coast College to host and supervise the Orange County Regional Director for Retail, Hospitality, and Tourism (formerly called Deputy Sector Navigator for Retail, Hospitality, and Tourism). The Regional Director facilitated collaboration in the retail, hospitality, and tourism occupations sectors and brought together education and industry partners to achieve the goals of the Economic and Workforce Development Program.

**Fiscal Impact:** Orange Coast College received \$200,000 from July 1, 2019 to September 30, 2020. Matching funds of \$200,000 were required. Sources of matching funds were industry and college in kind match.


