#### **21.04 DIS - Approval of Change Order No. 1 for Orange Coast College Language Arts and Social Sciences Project- Bid No. 2141 - Bid Package 3**

On a motion by Trustee Hornbuckle, seconded by Trustee Prinsky, the Board voted to approve Change Order No. 1 to the Standard Contractor Agreement with Interpipe, Inc. and authorized the Board President or designee to sign any related documents, indicating approval by the Board of Trustees.

On August 21, 2019, the Board of Trustees approved twenty-two multi-prime contracts to begin the construction of a new three-story, 107,760sf Language Arts and Social Sciences Building. Due to a conflict with the designed foundations of the Language Arts and Social Sciences Building, the change order replaced the existing 12" storm drain line which served the OCC Math, Business and Computing Center Building with a new 12" PVC storm drain that intercepted the existing drain line, avoiding the new foundation. After a review by the Facilities, Maintenance and Project teams, Change Order No. 1 was determined to be the most expedient and cost-effective solution.

As such, the Student Trustee's votes recorded within these minutes are advisory only in nature and are not counted in the final outcome of each action taken by the Board. Additionally, per Board Policy 2015, the Student Trustee does not participate in Closed Session meetings of the Board, therefore, votes reported from Closed Session will not include a reference to the Student Trustee.*
