### **3.01 The Trustee Fellowship Program**

In December 2019, the Coast Community College District was invited to have two members of the Board of Trustees and the Chancellor participate in the Trustee Fellowship Program, under the auspices of the State Chancellor's Office, the Foundation for California Community Colleges, and the Aspen Institute ("Trustee Fellowship Overview"). Coast Community College District Trustees Lorraine Prinsky and Mary Hornbuckle agreed to represent the Board of Trustees by attending the Fellowship Program with Chancellor Weispfenning.



The Program was originally planned as two one-day conferences, with the first session to be held in San Diego in April. When the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic became clear, the format of the Fellowship Program was shifted to two three-hour online meetings and the second meeting was July 24, 2020, which Trustee Prinsky, Trustee Hornbuckle, and Chancellor Weispfenning attended.

Dr. Andreea Serban, Vice Chancellor of Educational Services, presented equity gap information the Trustees could use in setting priorities and expectations of the District in anticipation of the Autumn Workshop for the Fellowship scheduled to take place virtually on October 29th.

##### **17.01 DIS - Standard Professional Services Agreement with UCMI, Inc.**

In accordance with 2019 California Administrative Code: Section 4-333 et seq, school construction projects require a Division of State Architects (DSA) approved project inspector to perform project oversight including the following: (A) Inspection of all portions of the construction for compliance with the DSA approved construction documents. (B) Identification, documentation, and reporting of deviations in the construction from the approved construction documents. (C) Submittal of verified observation reports to DSA for duration of the project.

To ensure compliance with these regulations, Coastline College solicited cost proposals from multiple DSA inspection firms and recommended the selection of UCMI, Inc. to provide DSA Inspection Services.

**17.02 DIS - Amendment #1 to the Standard Construction Management Agreement with Sundt Construction Inc.**

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Hornbuckle, the Board voted to approve Amendment #1 to the Standard Construction Management Services Agreement with Sundt Construction.

Amendment #1 to the Standard Construction Management Services Agreement with Sundt Construction was a result of delays experienced during the California Geological Society (CGS) and Division of State Architect (DSA) approval process. CGS submittal/review went through several iterations as the State reviewer requested more detailed analysis of the poor soil conditions at the Golden West College campus. Physical testing and analysis of the data was required to validate design assumptions. DSA would not review project plans until the CGS approval process was complete. During the delay, Sundt continued to support the project by participating in weekly project meetings, analyzing the cost and time impacts of potential solutions to the design and scheduling issues, and working with the team to resolve constructability issues.

An additional project cost estimate, based on DSA-approved documents, was prepared to support the application to the State Chancellor's Office for cost-sharing construction of the project.

The Participation Agreement revision added a new COVID-19 Remote Instruction Improvement Efforts project to improve student access to online instruction (additional \$48,560). This revision also added Regional Director Funding for Advanced Transportation and Logistics (additional \$92,000). Total funding was increased from \$248,000 to \$388,560.

#### **20.04 DIS - Bid Tabulations and Award of Contract for Contractor Services for Coastline College Student Services Center; Bid No. 2152**

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Hornbuckle, the Board voted to award the Standard Contractor Services Agreements for Bid No. 2152 to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for Bid Packages 2-23, excepting of bid packages 17 and 22, and authorized the Board President or designee to sign all documents.

As part of the Vision 2020 Facilities Master Plan, Coastline College sought to construct a new 2-story Student Services Center building totaling 53,000 square feet adjacent to the existing College Center building in Fountain Valley.

The project was procured via multiple prime trade contractors with C.W. Driver acting as the District's construction manager. It was anticipated that construction would commence in December 2020 and be completed by August 2022. All work was subject to the requirements of the Community Workforce Agreement (CWA) between Coast Community College and the Los Angeles/Orange County Building Trades Council dated May 2, 2019.

Notices were published in the Daily Pilot on June 7, 2020 and June 14, 2020 notifying potential bidders of the prequalification opportunity. In addition, notices of this prequalification were sent to 1,151 potential bidders via the direct bid notification system through the Planet Bids Portal. One hundred forty prequalification applications were submitted of which 104 bidders were pre-qualified. Fifty-four bids were received and opened on September 15, 2020.

Upon completing the review of the bids, low bidders were identified and the verification process was initiated. As part of this process, C.W. Driver reviewed the scope of work of the two lowest bidders in each package and conducted interviews with the apparent low bidder in order to validate the understanding and accuracy of each bid. After review, it was recommended that contracts be awarded to the lowest responsive and responsible bidder for each trade package.

On November 6, 2012, the voters of the District approved Measure M, which authorized the issuance of up to \$698,000,000 of general obligation bonds to construct, modernize and equip District facilities. The District has previously sold five series of Bonds under Measure M. At the September 16, 2020 meeting of the Board of Trustees, an informational report was provided addressing the 2020 Refunding of the Bonds under the Measure M General Obligation (GO) Bond Program. The staff report identified an estimated \$20 million in savings for the tax payers associated with the action.



The Coast Community College District (the "District") had previously issued its (i) Election of 2012 General Obligation Bonds, Series 2013A, (ii) 2013 General Obligation Refunding Bonds, Series A, and (iii) 2015 General Obligation Refunding Bonds (collectively, the "Prior Bonds"). The District desired to advance refund portions of the outstanding Prior Bonds (so refinanced, the "Refunded Bonds"), thereby generating savings for District taxpayers, through the issuance of general obligation refunding bonds (the "Refunding Bonds") pursuant to Government Code Section 53550 *et seq.* The refunding the 2015 General Obligation Refunding Bonds was the principal driver of this transaction. All benefits from the refunding would be delivered to the property owners in the District. The final maturity of the Refunding Bonds was not later than the final maturity date of the Refunded Bonds.

**Fiscal Impact:** There was no fiscal impact to the General Fund resulting from the issuance of the Refunding Bonds.


