21.01 DIS - Funded Programs

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Hornbuckle, the Board voted to approve participation in the following funded programs and the contracts or amendments/revisions to contracts:

Golden West College received funding from the California Community College Chancellor's Office for the 2021-2022 Nursing Enrollment grant. This grant enabled the College to continue to admit 10-20 additional students per year to contribute to the nursing workforce. Funds were used for TEAS Exam/Assessment, student remediation and retention activities to assist in preparation for the NCLEX-RN Examination, NCLEX-RN Review Course, and a part-time Student Success Coordinator.

Fiscal Impact: Golden West College received \$103,290 from July 1, 2021 to June 30, 2022. No matching funds required.

Orange Coast College received a revision to the funding from the U.S. Department of Education, under the federal Coronavirus Aid, Relief, and Economic Security (CARES) Act, 50% Institutional Portion, to cover costs associated with significant changes to the delivery of instruction due to the coronavirus such as expand remote learning programs, build Information Technology capacity to support such programs, and train faculty and staff to operate effectively in a remote learning environment. The revision extended the grant end date from April 20, 2022 to May 11, 2022. All other terms and conditions of the grant remained the same.

Fiscal Impact: Orange Coast College received \$34,093,492 from May 6, 2020 to May 11, 2022. No matching funds required.
