20.01 DIS - Non-Standard Independent Contractor Agreement with PFM Asset Management

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted to approve the Non-Standard Independent Contractor Agreement with PFM Asset Management LLC.

On November 6, 2013, the Board approved a Non-Standard Agreement with PFM Asset Management for investment advisory services. Since the execution of that agreement, PFM Asset Management managed the 2013B (\$10 Million) and 2016C (\$30 Million) bond portfolios for a total of \$40 Million. This represented the current assets Coast had in the Measure M Endowment. Consistent with recent legislation (AB 2738) the 2017E (\$20 Million) proceeds were managed by the County Treasurer.

PFM Asset Management LLC helped the District create and implement an investment strategy for the Building Fund created by the District's Series 2013B and 2016C bond issuances described above. As the terms of the initial agreement expired in 2022, approval of the new agreement continued services, allowing PFM Asset Management to manage the funds to prudently optimize investment returns, provide liquidity, and comply with the requirements of California Government Code and the appropriate bond documents.

Term: February 2, 2022 - June 30, 2026

Fiscal Impact: Annual fee based on the total assets under consultant management and invoiced monthly according to the fee table below. Total estimated cost to be \$37,000 per year. Paid with District Capital Outlay Project funds.

21.01 DIS - Funded Programs

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted to approve participation in the following funded programs and the contracts or amendments/revisions to contracts.

Coast Community College District received a Workforce Innovation and Opportunity Act (WIOA) Title II Adult Education and Family Literacy Act grant from the California Department of Education. The grant provided supplemental funds for adult education to (1) assist adults to become literate and obtain the education, knowledge, and skills necessary for employment and economic self-sufficiency; (2) assist adults in attaining a secondary school diploma and post-secondary education and training, including through career pathways; and (3) assist immigrants and other individuals who are English language learners.

Fiscal Impact: Coast Community College District received \$158,640 from July 1, 2022, to June 30, 2023. No matching funds required.

Golden West College received the Year 3 funding from the U.S. Department of Education, Developing Hispanic-Serving Institutions Program, for the Title V grant titled Gateway 2 STEM. Funding expanded educational opportunities for, and improved the academic attainment of students, Hispanic students in particular; and expanded and enhanced the academic offerings, program quality, and institutional stability of the College.

Fiscal Impact: Golden West College received \$600,000 from October 1, 2022 to September 30, 2023, and an anticipated total of \$3,000,000 from October 1, 2020 to September 30, 2025. No matching funds required.

Golden West College sought contractor services to install new Polyvinyl-Chloride (PVC) roofing at Technology Building. The contractor was to remove and dispose of existing membrane roofing system from deck and install owner furnished Tremco PVC roofing system.

Notices were published in the Daily Pilot on September 1, 2022 and September 8, 2022. Additionally, notices were sent out to 87 vendors using the Planet Bids portal. An onsite job walk was conducted on September 9, 2022 and eight bids were received and opened on September 20, 2022.

On a motion by Trustee Prinsky, seconded by Trustee Moreno, the Board voted to adopt Resolution #22-50 as revised authorizing the use of a cooperative purchasing agreement to purchase cabling infrastructure from Advanced Cable Solutions, Inc. to expand wireless coverage for Orange Coast College and Golden West College.

Public Contract Code Section 20652 provided authority for the Board of Trustees, without advertising for bids, to use another public agency's contracts for the lease or purchase of equipment, materials, supplies, or other personal property when the Board determined the transaction to be in the best interests of the District. Outdoor expansion of wireless coverage areas at Orange Coast College and Golden West College improved student learning by allowing access to college network resources in a greatly expanded coverage area of the campuses. To accomplish this, the installation of a reliable backbone cabling and mounting infrastructure was required to properly support the wireless hardware.
