Coast Community College District received a modified Participation Agreement for the Employer Engagement grant from the California Community College Chancellor's Office via Rancho Santiago Community College District. Through funding from the Orange County Regional Consortium, each community college district received an equal share of Employer Engagement funds to lead the region's effort to build more workforce-based learning, internships, and employment opportunities for students.

On September 7, 2022, the Board awarded Bid No. 2176, to California Commercial Pools, Inc for contractor services to remove and replace all tile and plaster at the Golden West College pool. During the process of demolishing the pool tile and plaster, water leakage was discovered underneath the pool floor that had to be located and corrected, resulting in unforeseen expenses. Change Order No.1 reflected the repairs, and the costs associated with the work.

On a motion by Trustee Moreno, seconded by Trustee Patterson, the Board voted to adopt Resolution #23-16 authorizing the use of a cooperative purchasing agreement to procure software and hardware upgrades from Climatec, LLC for Orange Coast College's Alerton Building Automation System in the Technology Building and Allied Health Sciences Buildings.

Public Contract Code Section 20652 provides authority for the governing boards of any community college district without advertising for bids, the use of other public agencies' contracts for the lease or purchase of equipment when the Board has determined it to be in the best interest of the District.

Orange Coast College sought approval to provide software and hardware upgrades for the Alerton Building Automation System in the Technology and Allied Health and Sciences Buildings. The enhancements increased the college's ability to regulate and control airflow intake in classrooms, and all obsolete Honeywell controls were replaced with new Alerton controls.

Public Contract Code Section 20652 provides authority for the governing boards of any community college district without advertising for bids, the use of other public agencies' contracts for the lease or purchase of equipment when the Board has determined it to be in the best interest of the District.

Resolution #23-17 allowed the use of a cooperative purchasing agreement to procure the necessary materials and labor to install approximately 15,300 square feet of artificial turf. The switch from traditional grass to artificial turf reduced maintenance costs, increased durability and improved environmental sustainability.

Fiscal Impact: \$361,551 paid with Scheduled Maintenance Funds.
