Coastline College received a revision to the funding for the Mathematics, Engineering, and Science Achievement (MESA) Program from the California Community Colleges Chancellor's Office (CCCCO). The purpose of the program was to recruit and support economically and educationally disadvantaged students in Coastline's STEM associate degrees for transfer and certificate programs. The revision added \$152,039 of funding. The grant term was corrected to start on January 1, 2023 and end on July 31, 2027. All other terms remained unchanged. **Fiscal Impact:** Coastline College received \$1,552,039 from January 1, 2023 to July 31, 2027. No matching funds required.

Orange Coast College received Amendment # 1 to the Innovation and Effectiveness Grant from CCCCO via Santa Clarita Community College District. The purpose of the grant was to support Orange Coast College to work over the next year on a holistic Strategic Enrollment Planning Project. Amendment #1 extended the end-term of the grant from August 14, 2023 to June 30, 2024 and approved the requested funding reallocation. All other terms remained unchanged.

Fiscal Impact: Orange Coast College received \$200,000 from July 6, 2020 to June 30, 2024. No matching funds required.

Orange Coast College received a No-cost Extension to funding for the Title V grant from the U.S. Department of Education, Developing Hispanic-Serving Institutions (DHSI) Program. The No-cost Extension extended the end term of the grant from September 30, 2023 to December 31, 2023 to continue grant activities while expending the remaining Year 5 budget balance of \$82,354. All other terms remain unchanged.

Fiscal Impact: Orange Coast College received \$2,747,986 from October 1, 2018 to December 31, 2023. No matching funds required.
