19.02 Resolution #24-22 Budget Revision, Increase of Income and Expenditure, April - June 2024, FY 2023-24

On September 6, 2023, the Coast Community College District Board of Trustees adopted the 2023-24 FY budget. Some programs were not known at the time of adoption of the District Budget, and at each quarter a resolution is advanced to the Board to reconcile emerging fiscal data. As of June 30, 2024, district administration is projecting to have a net budget increase of \$13,030,860 during 2023-24 FY. As this was not included in the 2023-24 Adopted Budget, it is necessary to adopt a resolution to increase income and expenditures for FY 2023-24.
