Due to an extended project duration. RVH Constructors Inc. was required to provide additional Stormwater Pollution Prevention Plan (SWPPP) services in compliance with Environmental Protection Agency (EPA) regulations through May 2, 2025. These services include the continued use of trench plates at the construction entrance to meet SWPPP compliance requirements. Change Order No.1 reflects these additional services, and the costs associated with this work have been reviewed by the project team who find them to be fair and reasonable.
