Description: Vendor to provide a comprehensive college rebrand responsible for strategy, identity development, stakeholder engagement, and production of core brand elements. 19.01 DIS - Non-Standard Renewal Agreement with Ready Education, LLC

Description of Services/Project: Since June 2017, all three colleges have used a mobile application to enable the colleges to provide timely and relevant information to

students and to enable students to access and share information pertaining to academics, important deadlines, activities, communities, and other products. In addition, the mobile application is integrated with information from Canvas, the district learning management system, such that students can see on the mobile application information about their courses in Canvas. This renewal agreement ensures the continuity of utilizing this mobile application by all three colleges.

Term: August 17, 2025 – August 16, 2028

Fiscal Impact: \$248,260 total cost for three years for annual license fees paid from general and categorical funds. The cost is paid based on annual invoices: \$78,750 for August 17, 2025 to August 16, 2026; \$82,688 for August 17, 2026 to August 16, 2027; \$86,822 for August 17, 2027 to August 16, 2028.

20.02 DIS - Funded Programs

Coastline Community College received a Project Extension to expend remaining funds for the Strong Workforce Program – Regional (SWP-R) 2023-25 Paving Equitable Pathways in Cybersecurity Project. The regional project is led by Coastline Community College, and includes Cypress College, Fullerton College, Irvine Valley College, North Orange Continuing Education, and Saddleback College. The Extension extends the grant end term from June 30, 2025 to December 31, 2025 to allow Irvine Valley College to expend its remaining \$19,099.

Fiscal Impact: Coastline Community College receives \$638,716 from July 1, 2023 to December 31, 2025. No matching funds required.

Coastline Community College received a Project Extension to expend remaining funds for the SWP-R 2023-25, Innovation in Instruction: Credit for Prior Learning and Competency Based Education (CPL and CBE) Project. The regional project is led by Coastline Community College, and includes Cypress College, Fullerton College, Golden West College, North Orange Continuing Education, Orange Coast College, Saddleback College, and Santa Ana College. The Extension extends the grant end term from June 30, 2025 to December 31, 2025 to allow Fullerton College to expend its remaining \$18,435; Saddleback College to expend its remaining \$120,330; and Santa Ana College to expend its remaining \$26,616.

Fiscal Impact: Coastline Community College receives \$432,488 from July 1, 2023 to December 31, 2025. No matching funds required.

Golden West College received a Project Extension to expend remaining funds for the SWP-R 2023-25, Cosmetology Regional Project. The Regional project is led by Golden West College, and includes Fullerton College, Saddleback College, and Santiago Canyon College. The Extension extends the grant end term from June 30, 2025 to December 31, 2025 to allow Fullerton College to expend its remaining \$12,939.

Fiscal Impact: Golden West College receives \$125,000 from July 1, 2023 to December 31, 2025. No matching funds required.

21.03 DIS - Bid Tabulations and Award of Contract for Contractor Services for the Orange Coast Breezeway Renovations Buildings 12-14 Project; Bid No. 2207

Description of Services: Orange Coast College is seeking contractor services for planned alterations to Buildings 12, 13, and 14. The scope of work includes replacing and reconstructing the existing walkway canopy, clerestory windows, HVAC system, air

ducts, and door hardware. Project will also include repairs to waterproofing membrane and site work/landscaping improvements. Construction is anticipated to begin on August 7, 2025, with completion expected by April 30, 2026.

Notices were published in the Daily Pilot on June 12, 2025, and June 2, 2025. Additionally, notices were sent out to 513 vendors utilizing the Planet Bids portal. An onsite job walk was conducted on June 20, 2025, and nine bids were received and opened on July 3, 2025.
