BP 4225 Course Repetition and Repeatability

Students who receive a substandard grade of "D", "F", "NC", or "NP" or an evaluative symbol of "W" in a course may repeat the course two additional times for credit. Prior student grades, when such repetition takes place, will be disregarded for the purposes of grade point computation; however, the academic record shall be annotated in such a manner that all work remains legible.

Under special circumstances, students may repeat courses in which a "C" or better grade or a "P" was earned. The special circumstances are defined in Administrative Procedure 4225.

Colleges in the District may designate certain types of courses as repeatable as set forth in Administrative Procedure 4227. Courses so designated may be repeated for credit the number of times indicated in the course catalog and class schedule.
