**BP 4400 Community Services Programs**

Education Code Section 78300

The District shall maintain a community services program that offers courses in civic, vocational interest, literacy, health, homemaking, local historical interest, technical and general education, including, but not limited to, classes in the fields of music, drama, art, handicraft, science, literature, health and safety, nature study, aquatic sports, athletics, recreation, and travel.

The community services program shall be designed to contribute to the physical, mental, moral, economic, or civic development of the individuals or groups enrolled in it.

Community services courses shall be open for the admission of adults and of those minors as in the judgment of the Board of Trustees may profit therefrom.

No General Fund monies may be expended to establish or maintain community services classes. Students involved in community services classes shall be charged a fee not to exceed the cost of maintaining the courses and/or programs. Courses may also be offered for remuneration by contract or with contributions or donations of individuals or groups.
