BP 4902 Artificial Intelligence in Academics

The District maintains an environment wherein faculty are able to explore, adopt, and appropriately incorporate the processes and product of various Artificial Intelligence (“AI”) tools and platforms for the purposes of educating, reinforcing, empowering, and supplementing, but not supplanting, instruction as a means toward furthering student learning and success.

The District recognizes the impact that AI tools can have on a student’s educational experience. AI tools have the potential to accelerate, make accessible, and support the acquisition of knowledge. Inappropriate use of AI tools can also supplant the acquisition of skills that students are expected to attain in the course. Students should be provided with clear expectations around the use of AI tools in classes and the extent to which permissions vary.
