BP 5055 Enrollment Priorities

The philosophy of the District is that all students should have fair and equitable access to courses and programs in pursuit of their educational goals, within the resource limits of the institution and in accordance with Education Code and Title 5 provisions.

Recognizing that not all students can be first to enroll, the District provides priority registration for students who enroll in one of the District colleges for the purpose of degree or certificate attainment, transfer to a four-year college or university, or career advancement. Furthermore, the District provides an opportunity for earlier registration for students who maintain good academic standing and have not exceeded 100 earned degree-applicable units across the three colleges in the District.
