BP 5120 Transfer Centers

The District recognizes the transfer of its students to baccalaureate level institutions as one of its primary missions. The District further recognizes as a priority the support for underrepresented students, including African-American, Chicano/Latino, American Indian, disabled, low-income and other students historically and currently underrepresented in transfer to baccalaureate level institutions which are accredited by regional accreditation agencies recognized by the US Department of Education such as Middle States Commission on Higher Education; Higher Learning Commission; New England Association of Schools and Colleges; Southern Association of Colleges and Schools; Northwest Commission on Colleges and Universities; and Western Association of Schools and Colleges. Each college in the District shall maintain a Transfer Center and provide services to facilitate the student transfer to baccalaureate level institutions.

The Chancellor shall assure that a transfer center plan is implemented at each college that identifies appropriate target student populations, is designed to increase the transfer applications of underrepresented students, and complies with law and regulations.
