BP 6970 ENVIRONMENTAL RESPONSIBILITY

The Chancellor shall make diligent efforts to reduce resource wastes to as low a level as is practicable without compromising the basic mission of the District; to help students and members of the community understand the need for wise use of natural resources; to promote an understanding of the relationship between reduced consumption and the quality of our environment; and to demonstrate leadership in voluntary efforts to reduce use of certain critical resources.

The Chancellor shall develop a program of effective energy and other resources management in order to maintain a stable academic and physical environment for the District.

The District shall develop and maintain waste reduction, reuse, recycling, resource efficiency, and recycled-content product procurement activities into everyday business practices. To this end, the District adopts an Integrated Waste Management Program (IWMP).
