a) General DSC Reports

Amelia Le:

- Coastline is celebrating Hispanic Heritage Month from September 15th to October 15th with various events on Canvas. Activities will include music and chocolate tasting, with an invitation to an event at the Newport campus happening today. Attendees are encouraged to support the artists.
- o Additionally, there is excitement for an upcoming conference.

Denise Rusk:

- The Coastline board is nearly complete, with only one position remaining open.
- We approved five students to attend CCCSAA.

Breanna Barrera:

- The outreach event attracted over 400 students, significantly higher than the usual turnout of 150 to 300. They had to end the event early due to running out of resources.
- We successfully grew our Instagram following, which will help engage more students for future events.
- Expressed excitement about working with the council.

Matthew Gonzalez:

- Golden West has a full board with nine executive council members.
- Approved the council members to attend the CCCSAA conference.
- Recent activities included outreach events on August 27th and 28th, followed by two info sessions on September 3rd and 4th to introduce students to the council.
- An advocacy committee event on September 17th will focus on the Constitution and National Voter Registration Day, featuring trivia and free donuts.
- Trivia night is scheduled for September 18th, with prizes and food, and a Club Expo on September 25th for clubs to showcase their activities.

Carla Santoyo:

 The Executive Council is almost fully in place, with most having their first meeting this week.

Lily Ei:

 There are 20 students planning to attend the CCCSAA conference. Efforts are underway to enhance involvement in PGCS, and someone has volunteered to take on the role of secretary, which is exciting for the group.

Savannah Garcia:

- The organization has been busy, recently completing a major event called Rush, which saw over 177 participants and helped grow club sizes significantly.
- Excited about increased registrations and member engagement.

- Upcoming events include a voter registration initiative by the advocacy committee to promote upcoming elections, scheduled for next Wednesday from 11 a.m. to 1 p.m., featuring snacks at the booth.
- Science Night is planned for next Sunday at OCC, showcasing various vendors including the San Diego Zoo.
- Organizing a speed-friending event on the 26th to help students build community on campus.
- Excitement is building for the CCCSAA conference as well.

Anastasia Levents Fedortsova:

- Attending participatory governance committees and mentioned that other committee members, particularly from the Senate, are also getting involved with campus committees and clubs.

The initiative is a trial to appoint more senators to participate in club activities, ensuring they understand funding requests and club operations.
