Associate Degree Requirements:

- 1. Completion of General Education Requirements by one of the following methods:
 - Completion of a minimum of 18 units as listed under Areas 1 through 7E below.
 - Completion of a minimum of 39 units of CSU General Education requirements.
 - Completion of a minimum of 34 units of Intersegmental General Education Transfer Curriculum (IGETC) requirements.

Students should consult a GWC counselor to select the best pathway to meet their educational goals.

- 2. Completion of a Major or Area of Emphasis: a minimum of 18 units.
- 3. Completion of additional elective units to total 60 units.
- 4. 2.0 overall Grade Point Average within 60 units used to satisfy degree requirements.
- 5. Completion of 12 units in residence within the Coast Colleges (Golden West College, Orange Coast College, and/or Coastline College).
