PROGRAM DESCRIPTION & GOALS:

The healthcare industry is one of the fastest-growing career fields. If you have a strong desire to help the elderly population and want a career in one of the most in-demand fields, the Senior Healthcare Technician program is your career choice.

Golden West College Noncredit Senior Healthcare Technician program prepares the student for an entry-level healthcare career profession as a Senior Healthcare Technician. Students will learn the foundational skills needed to provide adequate care to the elderly, seeking long-term therapeutic and personal assistance support upon completing the program.

The benefits of completing this new program are:

- 1. Employment Opportunities:** As the baby boomers' population ages, the demand for healthcare workers who specialize in senior healthcare is increasing. Offering a Noncredit Senior Healthcare Technician program can provide a trained workforce to care for the older adult population.
- 2. Free short-term job training:** The Noncredit Senior Healthcare Technician program can provide job training for individuals interested in pursuing a career in healthcare but who may need more resources or time to enroll in a full-time degree program.
- 3. Flexible and Accessible Schedule:** the free and accessible noncredit program can help busy working

adults who may have yet to consider attending college full-time. Classes are held online and in person.

4. **Supporting the local economy:** this program can support the local economy by helping to meet the needs of healthcare providers who serve the senior population.
