## **BP 6250 Budget Management**

## References:

Title 5 Sections 58307 and 58308

The District's budget shall be managed in accordance with Title 5 and the California Community Colleges Budget and Accounting Manual. Budget revisions shall be made only in accordance with these policies and as provided by law.

Revenues accruing to the District in excess of amounts budgeted shall be added to the District's reserve for contingencies. These funds are available for appropriation only upon a resolution of the Board that sets forth the need according to major budget classifications in accordance with applicable law.

Total amounts budgeted as the proposed expenditure for each major classification of expenditures shall be the maximum expended for that classification for the fiscal year, except as specifically authorized by the Board.

Board approval is required for changes between major expenditure classifications. Transfers from the reserve for contingencies to any expenditure classification must be approved by a two-thirds vote of the members of the Board. Transfers between expenditure classifications must be approved by a majority vote of the members of the Board.

The District will comply with Title 5, Section 58307 regarding budget transfers.
