Definitions

- Zero Textbook Cost (ZTC) & Open Educational Resources (OER)
- ZTC is critical to college affordability
- 60% CRNs are ZTC, 35 faculty are developing classes.
- Our Path to 60% ZTC and Growing
- Math Department at GWC Sets the Bar
- Next Phase of ZTC for GWC

Defining and Understanding ZTC

- **▼ ZTC:** Zero Textbook Cost course content materials that all enrolled students have access to, use free of charge. <u>S.B. 1359</u>
- **OER: Open Educational Resources (OER):**
 - Teaching, learning and research materials
 - Any Format (digital, print, audio, etc.)
 - Reside in the public domain or have been released under an open license that permits no-cost access, use, adaptation and redistribution by others with no or limited restrictions. <u>UNESCO</u>

GWC's ZTC Path



ZTC origins at GWC

- In **2014** focus on OER
- Associated Student Government request of faculty and funding
- Grassroots among interested faculty across campus
- Over time, more faculty buy-in with more and better quality OER

ZTC evolves to include non-OER options

- Faculty curate and create content to develop ZTC courses
- Library support to find free resources
- Librarian support to advocate for campus e-book and database funding to be used in ZTC classes by faculty

Spring 2025 – Math is 100% ZTC!

- Under the leadership of Shawn Taylor, Math at GWC is ZTC!
- Math content has not changed for centuries.
- BIG challenge: Technology-Math classes can be software dependent
- Faculty need support:
 - Stipends go a long way conversion is hard work
 - Support from administration is key
 - Faculty lead support is necessary for peers to buy-in
 - Focus on part-time faculty is especially crucial
- Changing culture takes time ZTC is mission-driven

ZTCs Next Phase at GWC



- President Randall set the goal: 100% ZTC at GWC!
- **⊕** HOW?
 - In 2016, the state allocated \$5 million to colleges (only 23% applied)
 - In 2021 the California Legislature designated \$115 million to develop ZTC degrees and pathways
 - GWC has received over \$300K in ZTC grants since 2021
 - We expect \$320K more later this year.
- New ZTC/OER Coordinator to focus on ZTC beyond OER
- New Faculty Stipends: GOAL convert 100 courses to ZTC by 6/30/26
 - 1. **OER** focused stipends
 - 2. **3C**: Create and Curate Content stipends
