## **AP 4010 Academic Calendar**

The number of days that define an academic year is 175 days of instruction and evaluation.

The District Academic Calendar Committee meets to establish the academic calendar per applicable laws, regulations, agreements and consultation with the collective bargaining units and meet-and-confer groups.

- Dr. Martin Luther King, Jr. Day
- Lincoln Day
- Washington Day
- Memorial Day
- Independence Day
- Labor Day
- Veterans Day
- Thanksgiving Day
- Christmas Day
- Other Holidays – Spring Holiday, the day after Thanksgiving, and Winter Holiday as defined in the agreements and consultation with the collective bargaining units and meet-and-confer groups.

For the purpose of delivering direct assessment competency-based education programs, the District will use the nonstandard term structure. A student may progress through the competency-based education module at their own pace. Modules will remain open until the student demonstrates mastery, until the student has exhausted the number of attempts pursuant to Title 5 Section 55270.9, or until the end of the designated term as determined by the College, whichever comes first.
