


What is the difference between CA Dream Act & DACA?



CA Dream Act	DACA (<i>Deferred Action for Childhood Arrivals</i>)
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • CA State law • Must meet qualifications and apply at www.caldreamact.org (Application is FREE) • Allows students to apply for and receive state financial aid • State Aid: (<i>qualifications vary</i>) <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • BOG Fee Waiver, Cal Grants, Chafee Grant, Institutional grants • Private scholarships for public Colleges 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Executive order, not law • Must meet qualifications and apply with USCIS, www.uscis.gov (Must pay a fee) • Temporary relief from removal (2 years), and obtain work permit, if granted • Does not equate to permanent legal status • <u>UPDATE: Announcement to rescind DACA made on September 5, 2017</u>
