Immerse yourself in experiential learning...

Spend the Summer in Rome studying photography with Accent Global Learning and the Coast Community College District (Orange Coast College). Attend photography courses with visiting faculty at the Accent Study Center, as well as with visits and lectures throughout Rome. Explore Roman historical and cultural sites, monuments, museums and galleries, as Rome becomes an extension of your classroom. Participants on the Summer in Rome Program live in double rooms in shared student apartments within a student residence. The Accent Rome Study Center provides support and guidance to students studying abroad.



Program Faculty - Chris Kerins & Jonathan Fletcher ^

Chris Kerins has been teaching Art and Architecture at Orange Coast College for the past 11 years focusing on illustration, drawing and watercolor. Additionally, he has taught at Brooks College and UCLA, where he also received his MFA in Design for theater and opera.

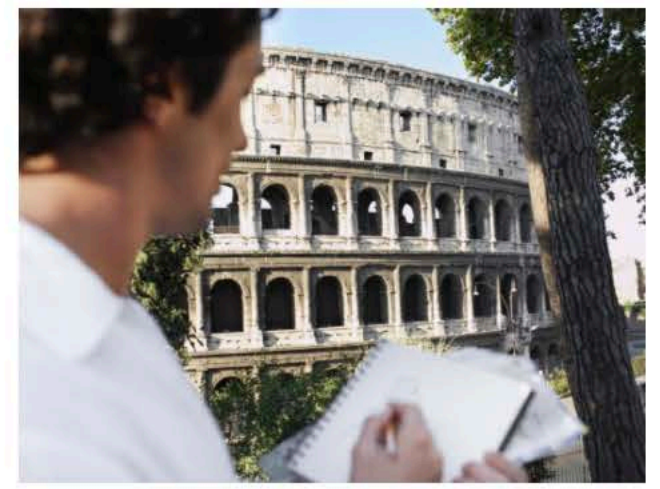
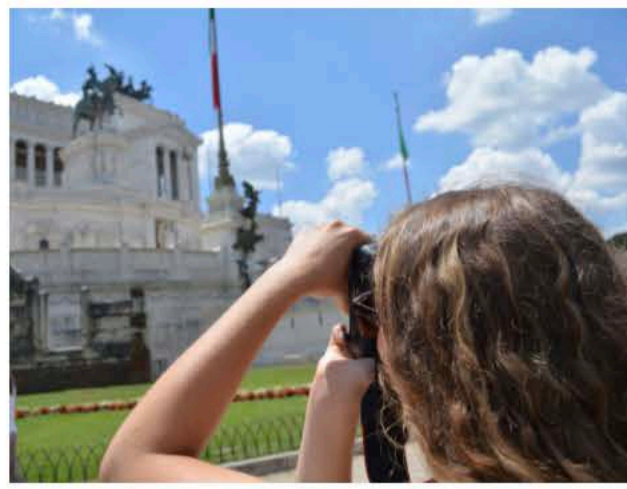
Jonathan Fletcher has been an instructor at Orange Coast College's The School of Photography for 17 years and continues to teach photography at several local colleges. He received his BA from UC Santa Barbara, and holds an MFA from the Art Institute of Boston. His photographs are held in collections throughout the country.

Application and Enrollment ^

The Summer in Rome Program is open to students who are at least 18 years of age at the time of application. Program space is limited. Students should complete the online application with the \$250 non-refundable first payment as soon as possible. Upon receipt of your application and first payment, Orange Coast College and Accent will provide you with additional application and enrollment forms. Applications must be received by April 1, 2022. Beyond April 1, limited enrollment is allowed when space permits.

Transferable Academic Credit ^

The Summer in Rome Program is offered for transferable college credit through Orange Coast College. Orange Coast College, an accredited California Community College, will provide a transcript upon request for the coursework completed overseas. Generally courses are transferable to the University of California and California State University systems. Please verify the transferability of courses with your advisor or registrar before you apply.



The Academic Curriculum ^

ART A120 Beginning Drawing or Art A 124 Advanced Drawing (3 units)

These classes offered by Chris Kerins are designed for the beginning and intermediate student. With Italy as our classroom, we will walk the streets of Rome and other Italian cities to find our subjects while learning the basic elements of shape, volume, and perspective. The technical application of diverse drawing materials will include charcoal, graphite, ink, and watercolor media to create illusionistic space and form. As part of class, we will visit museums and other areas of culture in the region. (UC/CSU)

Photo A100 Basic Digital Photography (2 units)

Instructor Jonathan Fletcher will offer this introductory course that is designed to help the photo enthusiast increase their visual literacy, increase knowledge of the historic use of photographs in all aspects of society, and to take better pictures. A practical foundation in the use of digital cameras will be introduced, including exposure, composition, lighting, color, as well as, current methodology of image processing. (CSU)

With all of Rome as your subject, assignments will be designed to explore and experience the region and its history. Course-related visits within Rome include the National Roman Museum, National Gallery of Modern Art, Galleria Borghese, Capitoline Museums, Vatican, Colosseum/Roman Forum, Baths of Diocletian, Trajan's Market, Piazza San Pietro, Piazza dei Fori, Piazza Navona, Piazza del Popolo, Campidoglio, Pantheon, and St. Peter's Basilica. *Visits are chosen based on the academic curriculum and are subject to change.*

Cultural Program ^

Cultural learning is an integral part of the program. Students participate in a cultural activity series that offers free or inexpensive activities that may vary from sports events to lectures on local customs. The program includes one cultural event such as a ballet or concert performance as well as one cooking class. Excursions included in the program are one day trip to Tivoli and Villa d'este, a two-day/one night excursion to Orvieto as well as a three-day/two-night excursion to Sorrento/Capri/Pompeii. Excursions include transportation, accommodation, guides, and entry fees. *Excursions are chosen based on the academic curriculum and are subject to change.*

All participants must check in at the designated arrival point on June 12, 2022 between 9am and 5pm (Note: most transatlantic flights arrive one day after their departure date). Accent will organize an optional round-trip group flight from Los Angeles. Group flight participants will be met at the airport in Rome and transferred to their housing. Group flight participants returning to the U.S. on the group return date will receive transportation to the Rome airport (group flight and airport transfers are based on a minimum of 10 group flight participants). Students enrolled in the Summer in Rome Program will receive detailed optional group flight information approximately four months prior to departure. Airfare is not included in the program fee. All participants will receive a Rome transit pass.

The health and wellbeing of all students, faculty and staff are paramount to Accent Global Learning. Accent has worked with a Medical Advisor following WHO and local health authority guideline to put protocols in place. Students will learn about COVID-19 related protocols, health resources and local regulations through pre-departure materials and in on-site orientations.

All participants are encouraged to be fully vaccinated against COVID-19. Many European sites, restaurants, museums and other venues require proof of vaccination in order to enter. Should a participant test positive for COVID-19, they will be required to self-quarantine in program housing at the student's expense.



Payment Schedule

Non-refundable first payment – \$250

The payment schedule is the applicant's contractual obligation. Failure to make each payment when due shall automatically cancel participant from the program one week after payment due date. All payments are effective the day they are received by the Accent U.S. Office. Accent, in its sole discretion, may reinstate an applicant subject to availability of space and late enrollment fees. Accent charges a \$30 bounced check fee for each check received that is not promptly paid by your bank in the normal course of business. The program price is based on 20 participants, the price may change depending on final enrollment.

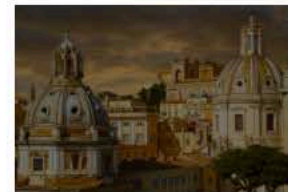
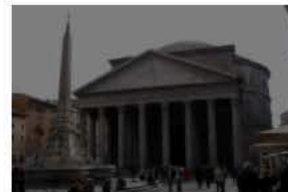
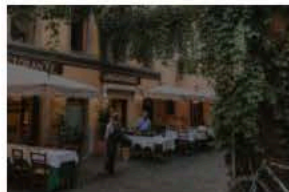
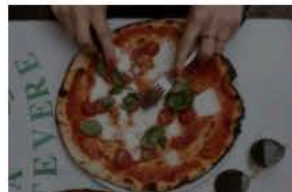
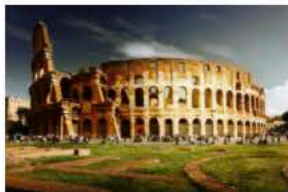
Cancellations
